



# Ludham Parish News - June 2018

The month of May in the Church Calendar helps us to reflect on what it was like for Jesus disciples post Crucifixion, Resurrection and Ascension. They were told to wait for the promised Holy Spirit before being released to carry on with Christ's Ministry here on Earth. This is what we call Pentecost. Pentecost Services help us to remember and celebrate that the Holy Spirit enables and helps all who are in need of God's help to make this earthly journey.

Christ promised us that we would not be left on our own, that if we turn to God to ask for help, the Holy Spirit will come. The writer of Matthew's gospel reminds us to "seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you", and we are entreated to try and focus on one day at a time, "do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own." Sometimes that is all one can do.

As we journey into June and summer we reflect on the Holy Trinity, we give thanks for the Institution of Holy Communion (Corpus Christi) and we begin to see in our calendar the appearance of the first Martyrs of the fledgling Church. These are those people who were killed for being courageous witnesses to faith in Christ. Justin, martyred in c165, Bernard Mizeki, martyred in 1896. Alban, first martyr of Britain c250.

In June we also are reminded about men and women who dared to speak of their faith in Christ as Lord and saviour, Evelyn Underhill 1941, Sudar Singh 1929, Etheldreda, Abbess c678, Cyril and Irenaeus, bishops and teachers of the faith.

We are fortunate to have many examples of holy men and women to inspire us and to help us along the way as we journey through this life on earth. And we also have each other. This is what we are about as the body of Christ here on earth. The Church is you and I and others meeting together, in one another's homes, or in the pub, or wherever it is, looking out for one another, taking care of one another, listening to one another, praying with and for one another, and looking out for those in our communities who are isolated, lonely or frail or in need of some T.L.C. **SHORELINE REPORT - JUNE 2018**

Foodbank: The Trussell Trust, who operate 428 Foodbanks across the country, report that the demand has risen by 13%. In the last year those Foodbanks handed out 1.3 million boxes of three-day food supplies to approximately 666,500 people. Two years ago an All-Party Parliamentary Group suggested that the need for emergency food had plateaued. These figures show that this is not the case and that every packet or jar you donate is helping someone who is really desperate for something to eat.

Wateraid: Your small change and pennies add up: - £24 buys tools to dig a trench for a water pipe: £60 buys a clean water tank for a school and £10.00 trains a person to maintain a water pump.

**HOW HILL TRUST - THE ENVIRONMENTAL STUDY CENTRE FOR THE NORFOLK BROADS**

The hidden woodland gardens known as the 'secret gardens', were established in the early 1920's by the original owner of How Hill House, Edward Thomas Boardman. The azaleas and rhododendrons are especially spectacular during May and June, and in October the autumn colours can be beautiful.

These gardens are open every day and access is signposted via the wood at the rear of How Hill House. A map and guide is available. Entry is free but donations to the How Hill Trust charity are welcome. The formal gardens surrounding the house are sometimes open. Please check the signs on the gates. If you would like to learn more about the history of the house and gardens, private tours with the Trust Director and Head Gardener can be arranged.

**At The How Hill Tearoom**

We serve a delicious selection of homemade cakes, scones and sandwiches, locally made ice creams and hot and cold drinks. The tearoom is located in the wooden building to the rear of How Hill House, as signposted from the public car park. We are open from 11am to 4pm:

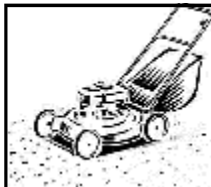

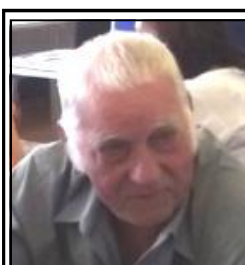

Community Speedwatch: Community Speed Watch (CSW) is a locally driven initiative where active members of the community join together with the support of the Police to monitor speeds of vehicles using speed detection devices. Vehicles exceeding the speed limit are referred to the Police with the aim of educating drivers to reduce their speeds. Volunteers receive appropriate training, and are supported by neighbourhood policing team (NPT) staff. - Reduce death and injury on the roads
- Improve the quality of life for local communities
